Azle, Texas – The City of Azle Economic Development Department announced today the launch of its two new websites: AzleAbsolutely.com and AzleSites.com.

The new websites were made possible by the City of Azle and the Azle Municipal Development District (MDD), a seven member political subdivision of the State of Texas and the City of Azle, created in accordance with Chapter 377 of the Texas Local Government Code. The District was created for the purpose of generating economic development and growth opportunities within the boundaries of the district.

AzleAbsolutely.com is a comprehensive economic development tool dedicated to providing corporate executives, site selection consultants, and local businesses with Information about the city’s economic climate, incentives, and resources for doing business in the city.

AzleSites.com features a geographic information system planning tool to search for available real estate properties, easily accessible economic data such as demographic, workforce, and education statistics.
